Laragai is a family home, hosted by Jay Macleod and Emily Upson, that sleeps 16 in sumptuous luxury surrounded by the stark beauty of the Highlands of Kenya.

Borana is steeped in a rich history, it is part of the adventure to rediscover the twists and turns of the area over the last 150 years. The ranch life is interwoven closely with the local communities; working together on projects such as the tannery, which employs blind and disabled people from the surrounding villages. The ranch supports a mobile clinic servicing the neighbouring area villages. Conservation of the area is at the top of our list of priorities. Sustainable management of the conservation resources, by engaging the local communities, and increasing awareness by sharing the experiences and surroundings with our guests, is at the heart of our philosophy.
