

Lukula Selous Camp

Southern Selous Game Reserve, Tanzania



Lukula Selous Camp is located within a private photographic sanctuary of over 300,000 acres of the southern Selous Game Reserve in Tanzania which is one of the largest wildlife sanctuaries anywhere in the world. The Selous is world renowned for its wild character and large populations of elephant, buffalo, lion and African wild dog.

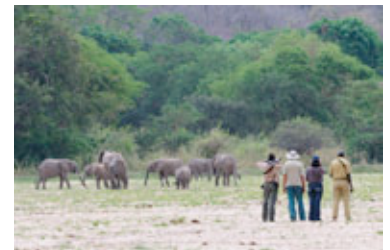
Lukula Selous provides an authentic wilderness retreat and experience. This is not a camp that just offers morning and afternoon game drives. At Lukula the key is connecting with the landscape and its wildlife – this can be from 4x4 vehicles, on foot and in an inflatable kayak or canoe.



Accommodation

Lukula Selous Camp accommodates a maximum of eight guests in four luxurious and spacious tents situated along the banks of the Luwego River. Each tent is authentic and stylish with beautifully worked pieces of campaign furniture. Ensuite facilities feature large open air bathrooms with bucket showers and flush toilets.

Power is provided 24 hours via the solar inverter. Please note the inverter cannot run hair dryers. Phone and camera batteries can be charged at the main charging station.



Amenities

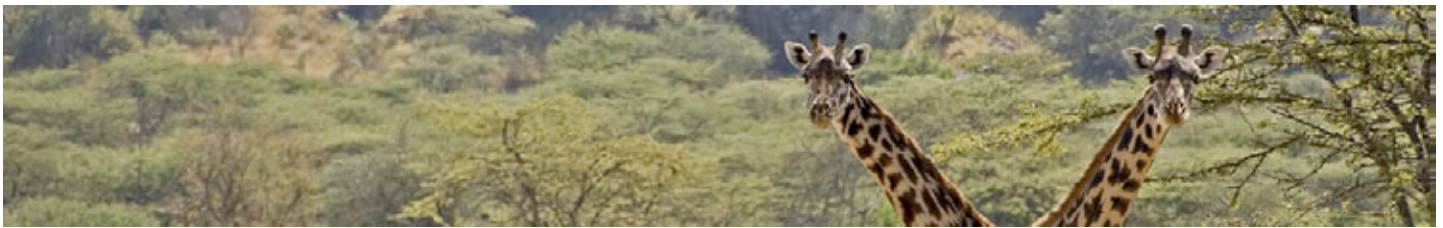
- Laundry services provided

- No credit card facilities

Full board accommodation, house-wines, beers & soft drinks. Excluding champagne. Special dietary requirements can be accommodated with prior notice.



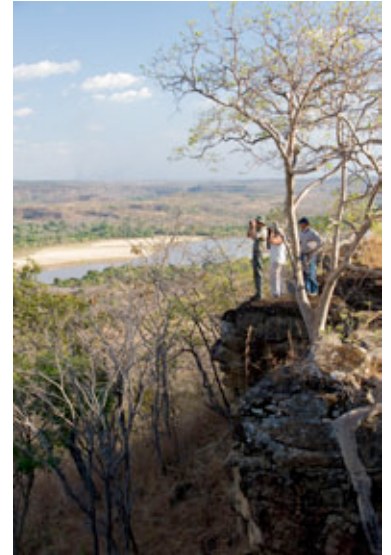


Included Activities
