

Oi Seki Mara Camp

Koiyaki/Masai Mara



Set on a rocky promontory, overlooking the Isupukiai River Valley, our luxury seasonal Oi Seki Camp enjoys panoramic views in a gorgeous wilderness area teeming with game on the eastern Koiyaki Conservancy, north of the Mara Reserve. The area provides a rare opportunity to enjoy wildlife viewing, in a pristine setting away from mass tourism. The oasis of inspired and beautifully designed tents is nestled amongst Cordia and Acacia trees attracting an abundance of wildlife and birds, many of which are seen from the tents in the valley below. The camp is hosted by Cathy Giovando and a team of dedicated and friendly staff.

Accommodation

Six light and roomy “Nina” tents each with a double and single bed with a changing room and ensuite bathrooms.

Two “suited” tents comprising of two bed roomed tents and ensuite bathroom, either side of a private living/dining area. Guests staying in the suites will benefit from their own private kitchen and a dedicated team of staff for each unit. Each suite also has its own game viewing vehicle.

Lighting is by generator, inverter and solar power. Hair dryers can be used in tents when generator is on and with prior warning to management. Phone and camera batteries can be charged in tents. Lock up trunk in each tent for valuables.

Lodge Amenities

- Large sitting room tent
- Laundry services provided
- Small gift shop
- Wi-fi internet access in some areas within camp
- Mobile phone networks
- No credit card facilities

Meal Plan

Full board accommodation, house-wines, beers & soft drinks. Excluding champagne. Special dietary requirements can be accommodated with prior notice.





Included Activities

- Shared game drives in 4x4 vehicles (roof hatches) with knowledgeable guides, both during the day and at night in the Koiyaki Conservation Area
- Game walks with an experienced guide
- Bush picnics, sundowners, bush dinners and star walks
- Visits to an ancient Ndorobo cave below the camp with our resident Ndorobo tracker
- Game viewing from your private verandah, binoculars in hand and star gazing at night
- Visits to the local and unspoiled enkangs or villages
- Visits to the Koiyaki Guiding School where skills of effective tourism and wildlife management and incentives to conserve the bio diversity of the area are taught. OI Seki Mara Camp pledges a bed night fee to support both their mission and those who live and protect this area.

- Balloon safaris – please book with Balloon Safaris (Keekorok). Guests need to be ready by 0405H to drive to the launch site
- Mara Game Reserve –US\$60 per person Mara Game Reserve fees. The Mara Game Reserve boundary is a one hour drive south from the Camp.



Access

- Daily scheduled flight to Siana Springs departing from Wilson Airport. Transfer to OI Seki is 40 minutes away and is included.
- Daily scheduled flight to Siana Springs departing from Nanyuki/Lewa/Laikipia. Transfer to OI Seki is 40 minutes away and is included.
- By private charter flight to Siana Springs or Koiyaki airstrip (20 minutes away)
- Please check luggage restrictions for all flights
